Ancient Egyptians believed in many gods (polyetheism) Ancient Egyptians wrote in hieroglyphics.	Ancient Egyptians built pyramids to act as tombs and monuments for the pharaohs before their journey to the afterlife. Inside the pyramids were chambers that contained all the items pharaohs would need for the afterlife.	The Egyptian process for preparing the body for the afterlife was called mummification. Mummification involved removing all the moisture from the body and leaving behind a dry version, which did not decay.	The Book of the Dead includes spells written to protect the dead and help the dead travel to the afterlife.	The Egyptians believed in different ways of reaching the afterlife.
