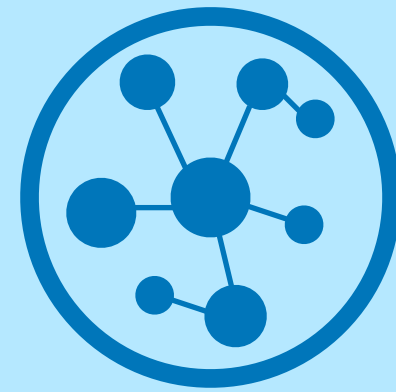


Information

Schema

Knowledge organised in a meaningful way - memories (emotional), concepts, knowledge

Second Order Concepts

'The kinds of questions Historians ask'

Second-order concepts: these shape the key questions asked in a subject and organise the subject knowledge.

Chronology

When did it happen?

How long did it take?

Which period of history came before?

Which period(s) of history came after?

Historical interpretation

What did this person think?

Why did this person think that?

What do other people think that is the same / different?

Historical significance

What changed as a result of this?

Why was this person important / significant?

Why was this event important / significant?

Change and continuity

What key things changed in this period of history?

What remains from this period of history today?

Similarity and difference

Was it the same for everyone?

Who was it different for?

Was it the same for everyone?

Sources and evidence

What or where is the evidence for this?

How do people know this?

What can this source tell me?

Can I trust this source?

Cause and consequence

Why did this happen?

What was the result of this happening?



Key Concepts (Big Ideas)

Key concepts identify the content or focus areas of study



Invasion

An army entering another country by force in order to take control of it.

Conflict

A serious disagreement or argument which usually results in fighting or war.



Faith

To believe or trust in a God or many Gods.

Settlements

A place where a group of people decide to live or gather together.



Propaganda

Communication (words, images, films etc) used to influence or persuade an audience.

Trade

Buying, selling or swapping goods between people.

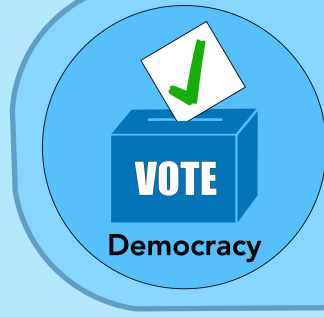
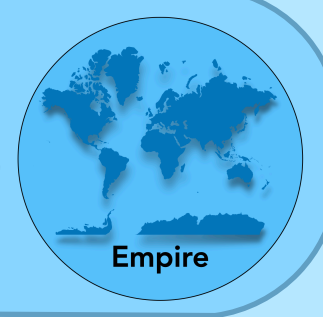


Legacy

Monarchy
